



## Technical Cooperation Programme

The aim of the Technical cooperation programme (TCP) of the Ministry of Finance of the Czech Republic is to contribute to the financial and economic transformation of the partner countries by sharing the experience of Czechia from the transformation, accession to the EU and public finance management.

Since 2007, 144 study visits from the Ministries of Finance of 37 countries. Almost a thousand participants from partner institutions increased their professional capacities within the programme.



At the request of partners, Czech Ministry of Finance organizes study visits, seminars, workshops and consultations on a wide scope of public finance issues. When relevant, the programme is complemented by the perspective of other Czech institutions.

Possible topics:

- Management & Control of Public Finance
- Tax and customs issues
- Regulation and methodology of PPP projects
- Investment arbitration and protection of investments
- Financial markets and financial services
- European integration
- Management and control of EU pre-structural and structural funds
- International financial institutions and development cooperation

The costs related to the project are covered from the TCP budget. The TCP can be coordinated and/or complemented with other programmes of the EU and its member states, as well as with multilateral and bilateral donor programs.
