## B. HOW TO REACH THE VENUE

### From Prague Airport (Václav Havel Airport)

By Metro & Public Transport (Approx. 40–60 min):

1. Bus 59: Take bus 59 from Terminal 1 or Terminal 2 to “Nádraží Veveslavín” (metro station).
2. Metro Line A (Green): From “Nádraží Veveslavín”, take the metro to “Muzeum”.
3. Metro Line C (Red): Transfer at “Muzeum” to Line C and go one stop to “Vyšehrad”.
4. Walk: The hotel is a short walk from “Vyšehrad” station.

 Total time: ~40 minutes

 Cost: ~40 CZK (approx. €1.60)

By Taxi or Ride-Hailing (Approx. 20–25 min):

Use official Taxi service “Uber Airport” by Uber application. More information [is here](#).

 Estimated fare: 1,300–1,700 CZK (approx. €55–70) depending on traffic and time of day

### From Prague Main Train Station (Hlavní nádraží)

By Metro (Approx. 10 min):

Metro Line C (Red): Board at Hlavní nádraží and go 2 stops south to Vyšehrad.

Walk: The hotel is nearby.

 Total time: ~10 minutes

 Cost: ~30 CZK (approx. €1.20)

By Taxi:

 Taxi or Bolt/Uber from the station takes about 10 minutes.

 Estimated fare: 200–300 CZK (approx. €8–12).

- Můstek – Metro lines A and B (approx. 7-minute walk)

## F. OTHER INFORMATIONS

**Language:** the official language is Czech but in most public places, restaurants and shops you can communicate in English.

**Currency:** Czech crown (“koruna”, CZK) - middle exchange rate: 1 EUR = 24,60 CZK. Almost everywhere you can pay by card.

**Telephone Code:** +420 followed by the Czech number.

**Emergency Number:** the emergency number in the Czech Republic is 112.

### Public transport:

Prague has an integrated transport system, meaning one ticket works across:

- Metro (Underground): Lines A (green), B (yellow), C (red)



- Trams: Day (1–26), Night (91–99), Historic (41), Tourist (22, 23)
- Buses & Trolleybuses: Including airport connections
- Ferries: Scenic river crossings
- Funicular: To Petřín Hill (currently under renovation until 2026)

#### Ticket Options (2025)

Ticket Type	Validity	Price (CZK)
Short Ride	30 minutes	30 CZK
Standard Ride	90 minutes	40 CZK
1-Day Pass	24 hours	120 CZK
3-Day Pass	72 hours	330 CZK

All tickets are valid across metro, tram, bus, ferry, and funicular (except Airport Express).

 Time starts from validation, not purchase.

#### How to Use

1. Buy a ticket:
  - At metro stations (machines or kiosks)
  - Newsstands or convenience stores
  - Mobile apps (e.g., PID Lítačka)
2. Validate your ticket:  
Insert into yellow validator on trams/buses or at metro entrances.
3. Hop on and go:  
Transfers are allowed within the time limit.

#### **Sightseeing:**

- Prague Castle – The largest castle complex in the world, featuring Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, Golden Lane, and beautiful gardens
- Charles Bridge – A medieval stone bridge adorned with statues, offering stunning views of the Vltava River and the city
- Old Town Square – Home to the Astronomical Clock, Týn Church, and vibrant street life.
- Vyšehrad – A historic fort with panoramic views, peaceful gardens, and the resting place of famous Czech personalities
- National Museum – A grand building showcasing Czech history, natural sciences, and culture
- Museum of Communism – Offers a deep dive into life behind the Iron Curtain in Czechoslovakia



- Klementinum – Features one of the most beautiful libraries in the world, the Mirror Chapel, and an astronomical tower
- Žižkov Television Tower – Known for its futuristic design and panoramic city views
- Letná Park – A scenic spot perfect for sunset views over the city with a cold Czech beer
- Petřín Hill & Lookout Tower – A peaceful green escape with a mini Eiffel Tower and rose gardens
- Lennon Wall – A colorful tribute to John Lennon and a symbol of peace and freedom
- Franz Kafka Museum – Dedicated to the life and work of the famous Prague-born writer

### Weather:

In November weather could be quite chilly and rainy, day temperature around 5 – 10 (°C) Celsius degrees. More info at: [Prague Weather 14 days - Meteored](#)

**Electricity:** Electricity in the Czech Republic is **230 V**, with a frequency of **50 hz**. Plug sockets are round with two round-pin sockets.
